

Direct Relief Paid to a Resident of North Kildonan 1936 – 1940

The amounts below were paid to one particular family of 5, 2 adults and 3 children living in North Kildonan in the years 1936-1940. The family lived in their own home a 20-foot by 24-foot shack with no plumbing heated by cordwood on a small market garden plot. Relief had to be worked off on relief projects or by paid back after regular employment was obtained. Until the full amount of the relief was repaid, a lien was placed on the property and if the property taxes were not paid the property could be taken over by the municipality after the taxes were 3 years in arrears.
