

# EAST KILDONAN COUNCIL INCREASES LICENSE FEE CERTAIN BREEDS OF DOGS

License Fee Takes Jump of One  
Hundred and Fifty per Cent.

—Appointed Police Con-  
stables for Balance  
of Year

At a special meeting of the council of the municipality of East Kildonan held Monday night under the chairmanship of Reeve Larsen, some rather drastic amendments to the dog license by-law were effected. All the members of council were present.

The decision in the dog situation was to increase the license fee on certain classes of dogs. The breeds affected by the increase are: Police dogs, Alsatians, German Shepherd, Belgian Police, Huskies, Great Danes. In these cases the increased fee is \$5.00 for males and \$10.00 for females.

The license fee for all other breeds will remain as formerly, viz., \$2.00 and \$5.00 respectively.

At the same meeting Jos. I. Walker and Gilbert J. Russell were appointed to serve as police constables for the balance of the year 1935.
