

# FAMILY IS DRIVEN INTO STREET WHEN RESIDENCE BURNS

## Home at East Kildonan is Mass of Flames When Fire Fighters Arrive on Scene

M. Ludwick and his family were forced hurriedly into the street in scanty attire and his dwelling and contents at 248 Leighton avenue, East Kildonan, were destroyed, when fire, believed to have started from defective wiring, swept through it Sunday morning.

Awakened by the smell of smoke and the crackle of flames shortly after 7.30 o'clock, the occupants dashed into the street, having no time to salvage any of their possessions.

The flames spread so fast that the one and a half storey dwelling was a blazing mass with the arrival of the fire fighters.

Total damage was set at about \$2,000. The dwelling was insured to the extent of \$1,000, but no insurance was carried, on the contents, value of which was placed at \$500.
