

# SAYS KILDONAN TO SUE WINNIPEG FOR DUMPING SEWAGE

## Barry Warns Council of Move- ment on Foot in Suburban Municipality.

Warning of a movement on foot in East Kildonan to take action against the city of Winnipeg for the indiscriminate practice of dumping raw sewage into the Red river without regard to the resultant nuisance was sounded by Ald. James Barry at Monday night's meeting of the city council.

With the suit in court impending, he said, this might be an opportune time to interest the provincial government in a scheme for placing unemployed men to work on cleaning both the banks of the Red and Assiniboine rivers of refuse, and paying them a small cash wage.

The alderman said he would place a resolution before council at its next meeting urging the government to take appropriate action. But before making any move, he declared, he thought it best to bring the question to the attention of Ald. Honeyman, the representative of the city on the government board studying the problem of sewage disposal.

Ald. Barry said he had been prompted to speak on the action of East Kildonan as a result of a judgment regarding sewage dumping by a prominent member of a North Dakota court.
