

# 100-Bed Personal Care Home Planned In E.Kild.

## Several Ballots For Elmwood Voters on Oct. 23rd

Elmwood electors, as part of Ward 3 in the City of Winnipeg, will once again have lots of ballot papers and a large selection of candidates to choose from when they go to the polls.

Besides having two money bylaws totalling \$7¼ million, they will have six candidates for City Council, three to be elected, and four school trustees, with two to be elected, besides a mayoralty contest.

The money bylaws are \$5 million for storm sewers and \$2¼ million for recreational purposes.

The provincial government has approved grant support totalling \$200,000 and the sponsoring organization, the Menonite Benevolent Society, Bethania, will provide the required 10 per cent, in addition to the land.

Balance of the cost will be loaned by the Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation.

Plans call for a one-storey building probably of concrete block and brick veneer, with 75 per cent of the bed space allotted to single rooms and the balance to double rooms.

Small sitting rooms and a main lounge, large enough to accommodate various forms of entertainment, are included in proposed plans. A central dining room will service all the residents with tray service for those unable to leave their rooms.

A staff of 50, including trained nurses, will be needed when the new institution is in operation. Medical staff will be available from the nearby hospital.

The architectural firm of Smith Carter Searle will design the new building, and it is hoped construction can begin early this winter. Projected completion date is toward the end of 1969.
