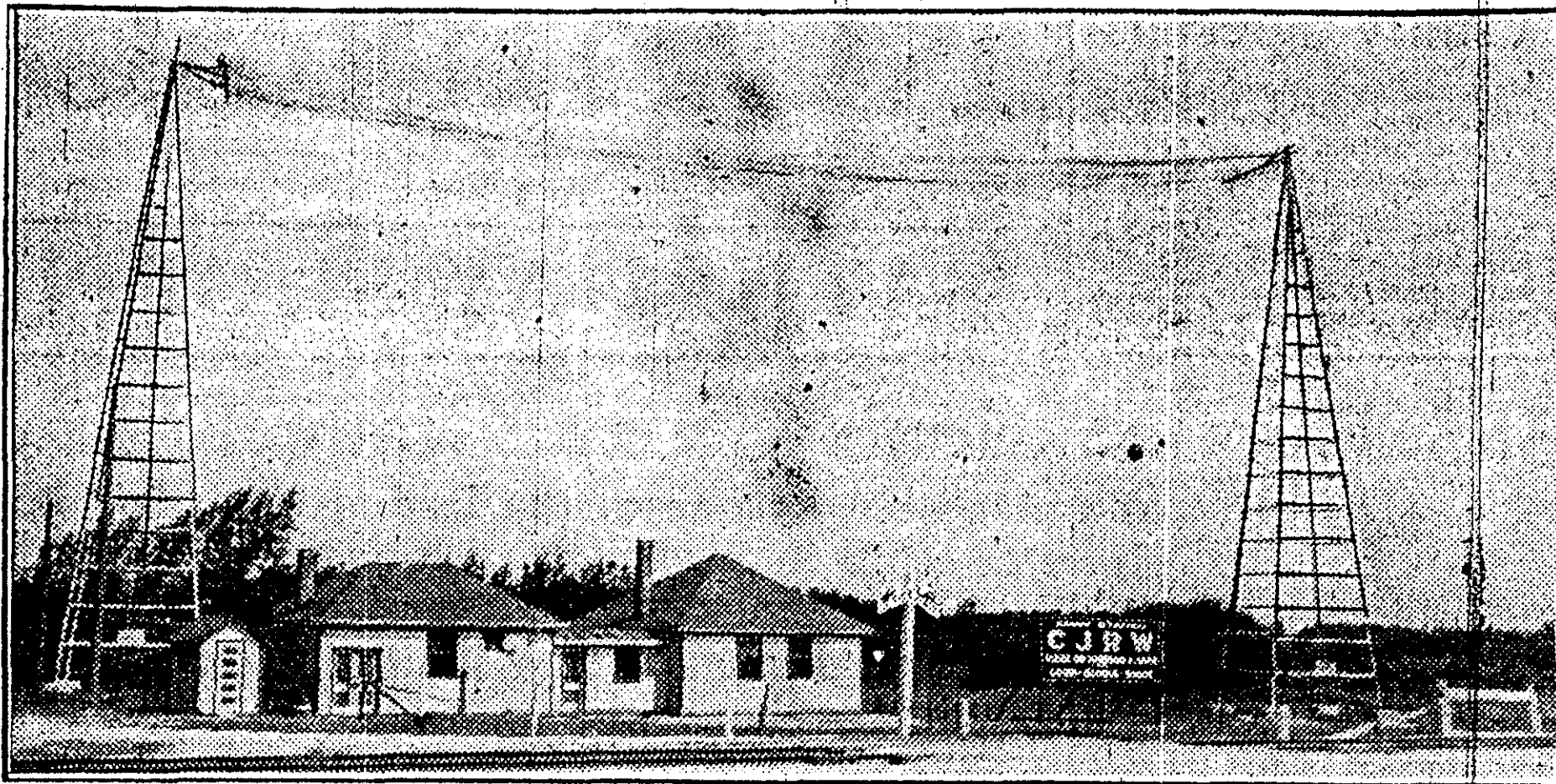

CJRW, NEAR MANITOBA-SASKATCHEWAN BORDER



Radio station CJRW, at Fleming, Sask., is owned and operated by James Richardson and Sons, limited. The photograph reproduced above shows the station buildings, located on the eastern edge of Fleming and about three miles west of the Manitoba border. Passengers on the C.P.R. main line get a good view of the station, as it is within a few hundred feet of the track, on the north side. From left to right, the buildings comprise, the store house, the power house and the operating room. CJRW is believed to be the only

station in western Canada making its own power and being thus independent of outside sources. The station is operated by specially built remote control lines on the C.P.R. telegraph system, connecting with the studio in the Royal Alexandra hotel, Winnipeg. The towers, each 85 feet in height, are surmounted by 500-watt lamps which are visible at night for many miles across the prairie. The mast-head lights of CJRW make a landmark at night for many miles around the town of Fleming.

CJRX is heard daily in VANCOUVER, LOS ANGELES, NEW ORLEANS, MONTREAL, HALIFAX, N.S., and has been received with loud-speaker volume in SYDNEY, Australia; GAMARU, New Zealand; PAPUA, British New Guinea; LONDON, Eng.; GRIMSBY, Eng.; ST. ALBANS, Eng.; BERMUDA, British West Indies; SAN JUAN, Porto Rico; and SANTIAGO, Cuba.

May be heard with short wave receivers or with ordinary broadcast receivers equipped with short wave adapters.
