

# First E.K. Traffic Lights Installed At Melrose Ave.

East Kildonan's first traffic lights erected at Melrose and Henderson Highway last week, commenced working Tuesday.

For the present the lights will be working from 7.30 to 9 a.m., 11.30 a.m. to 1 p.m., and 4 to 6 p.m.

The purpose of the lights is to break traffic and assist pedestrians to cross the highway.

Chief Einfeld, director of public safety, informed the Herald that "at the present time the council is experimenting with the times the lights will be required."

He further stated that a check being made of the traffic going north and south on the highway one day last fall showed that 1,109 cars came into East Kildonan in the one hour period between 5 and 6 p.m.

City traffic engineer H. F. Burns, who was working with Chief Einfeld on the problem at that time, said "It was phenomenal. I couldn't believe it."
