It is hoped that sufficient funds will be forthcoming to construct a memorial gazebo in the East Kildonan Centennial Park. The East Kildonan

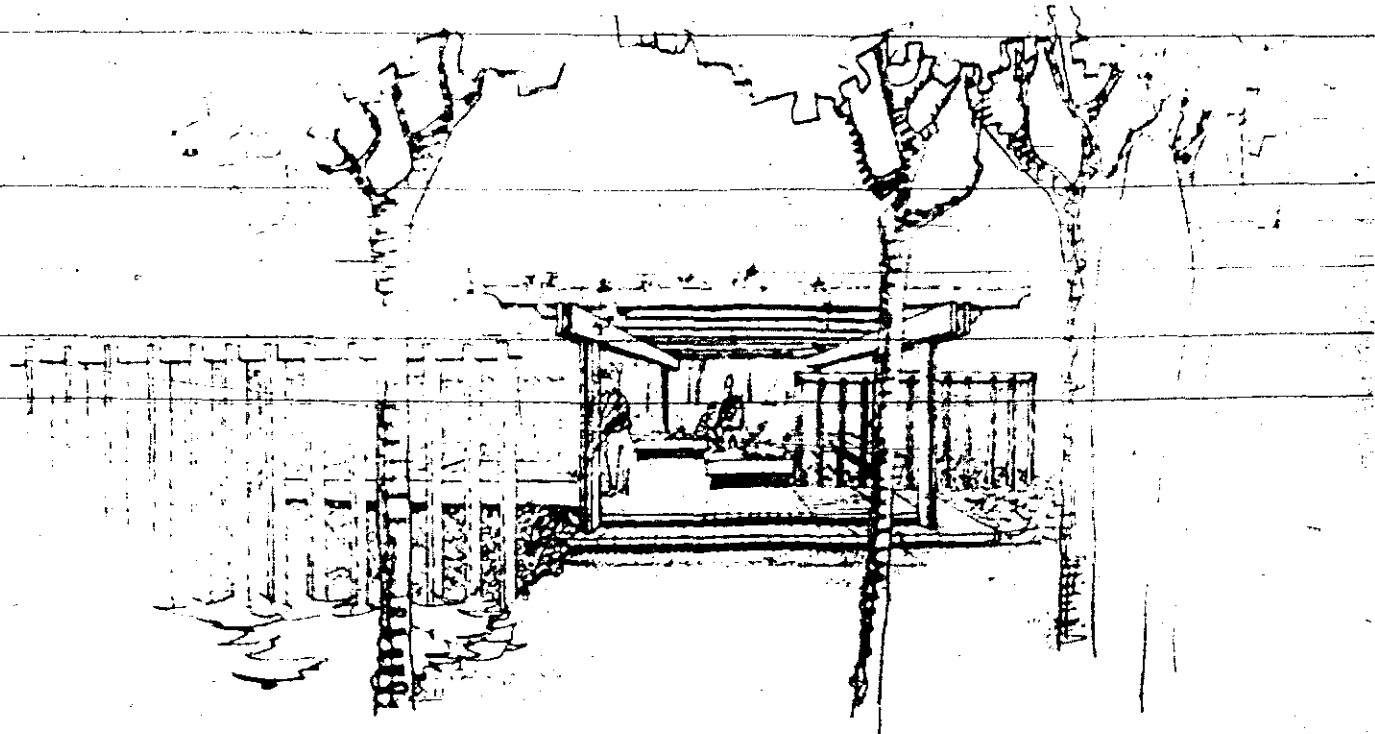
Parks Board has been approached and has unanimously adopted the plan.
