The new station is equipped with the most modern devices for servicing automobiles, including a hydraulic hoist and pressure greasing equipment.

The building, which measures 29x41 feet, is of concrete block construction and is faced on two sides with gleaming white vitrolite, a glass composition which gives it a sparkling clean appearance at all times. It is built of reinforced concrete foundation supported by spread piles. The area surrounding the building is hard-surfaced with asphalt.

The underground gasoline storage tanks will be of the maximum size permitted by municipal law, thus cutting to a minimum the frequency of product delivery by tank trucks.
