

# RELIEF WORKS EMPLOY TOTAL OF 8,304 MEN

Figures Given by Hon. W. R. Clubb Do Not Include Those for National Park

Relief works in Manitoba today are employing a total of approximately 8,304 men. Hon. W. R. Clubb, minister of public works, stated, Friday, in making a list of projects employing 3,304 of this total.

In addition to the works specified in his list, the minister said it is estimated that there is an average of 50 men working in fully 100 municipal works, making a total of 5,000.

Hon. Mr. Clubb's figures do not include the men employed in the Riding Mountain National park,

which is purely a federal project. The list follows:
