

Sample Salaries Shown In Table

Following is a table showing sample increases in pay for Manitoba's civil servants, announced in the legislature Friday by Hon. Charles E. Greenlay, provincial secretary.

The figures show the monthly salary ranges at present and as they will be after April 1. Employees enter their jobs at the minimum salary for each range, and receive annual increments, usually over a five-year period, up to the maximum amount.

The sample salaries shown below do not include a proposed new monthly cost-of-living bonus for those civil servants resident in The Pas, Flin Flon and Churchill. The bonus will be \$25 a month for married persons and \$12.50 for single persons.

The figures also exclude special food allowances for employees living in areas not served by railway or highway north of the 53rd parallel of latitude, and a \$10-a-month bonus for persons living in re-



note areas which are served by transportation facilities.

The food allowances are to the wholesale value of \$40 a month per adult, \$10 per child under 10, and \$20 per child between 10 and 21.

had to be treated differently as the need arose. Sometimes the market demanded higher salaries for some groups than for others.

The bonus suggestion, he said, was a "simple, but poorly thought out" solution to the problem.

"We have a pay plan which compares favorably with comparable jobs in other businesses," he said, adding that he thought the government should pay neither more or less than average rates in the province.

The province had a good civil service, and the government and people were getting "a good re-
