

# NEW SECRETARY IS NAMED IN KILDONAN

Harry Thompson of the Grain Growers Grain Company Succeeds  
G. F. Munroe.

Harry Thompson, who is at present assistant accountant of the Grain Growers Grain company, was on Saturday evening appointed secretary-treasurer of the Rural Municipality of Kildonan, in succession to George F. Munroe, barrister, who recently resigned the position.

There were 17 applicants for the position, but Mr. Thompson had the advantage of extensive experience in the work. He had for a period of five years prior to accepting his position with the Grain Growers company, been accountant for the firm of Munroe, Mackenzie and Macqueen, and during that time he acted as assistant secretary-treasurer of the municipality to Mr. Munroe. He is a native of Burton-on-Trent, England, and had also had municipal experience before coming to this country. He will assume the duties connected with his new office at once.

## Thirty-Seven Years Service.

George F. Munroe, the retiring secretary-treasurer, has acted in that capacity for Kildonan municipality for a period of 37 years. Recently his health failed, and he found that the duties were becoming too strenuous to be conducted in connection with his extensive law practice. He therefore resigned and is now taking a holiday at Los Angeles. A letter from Mr. Munroe received by a member of his firm yesterday states that his health is greatly improved and he expects to be back in Winnipeg about the beginning of April next.
