

New Bowling Lanes To Open August 10th

The latest bowling lanes to operate in East Kildonan will be opened next month.

Norman Loomer, president of Loomer Lanes, told the Herald Wednesday that the lanes will open August 10th, with the official opening date set for August 18th.

The new lanes will form part of the Rossmere Shopping Centre, opposite the Curtis Hotel, on the west side of Henderson Highway.

Loomer Lanes will have 20 lanes, and will operate daily from 9 a.m. to midnight. The lanes will be the latest in every detail, will be air-conditioned, and fitted with the most modern automatic equipment. There will be a snack bar, where coffee and sandwiches will be served.

At the present time Loomer Lanes are serving in the four western provinces. The first one in the Metro area was recently opened in Transcona. It is the company's intention, following the opening of the East Kildonan lanes, to go into St. Vital, where lanes on the Loomer lines will cater to the residents of that area.

The company's plans call for five installations in Metropolitan Winnipeg.

In business for 11 years, Mr. Loomer claims his chain is the fastest growing in the business.

Reservations are now being accepted by Bob Smith, regional supervisor. He will be in charge of the lanes and will also be responsible for hiring of staff.
