

WHERE AND WHEN

Minute-to-minute Time Table Of Their Majesties' Visit Here

As an aid to visitors and Winnipeggers generally, the official minute-to-minute time table of Their Majesties' visit to Winnipeg is reprinted below. All details covering the activities of the King and Queen in the city are included.

10.30 a.m.—Reception to Their Majesties at the Canadian Pacific railway station; artillery salute.

10.40 a.m.—Inspection by the King of the guard of honor.

10.45 a.m.—Royal party and mounted escort will leave the Canadian Pacific Railway station and proceed along Higgins avenue and Main street to the city hall.

10.53 a.m.—Reception at city hall.

11.08 a.m.—Leave the city hall and proceed along Main street to Portage avenue, thence west on Portage avenue to Memorial boulevard, thence along Memorial boulevard to the legislative grounds.

11.20 a.m.—Arrive and enter legislative building, south entrance. Proceed to reception room of the lieutenant-governor.

11.35 a.m.—Public reception to Their Majesties by the provincial government at the north entrance to legislative building.

11.55 a.m.—Return to lieutenant-governor's reception room.

12.20 p.m.—The royal party proceeds to Government house.

1.09 p.m.—World broadcast by His Majesty, the King.

1.30 p.m.—Luncheon at Government house.

In Afternoon

3.15 p.m.—Leave Government house via Kennedy street and Assiniboine avenue to Osborne street, via River avenue to Wellington crescent, thence via Assiniboine River drive to Assiniboine park.

3.41 p.m.—Enter Assiniboine park gates off Assiniboine River drive.

3.51 p.m.—Leave park bridge, St. James, for Deer Lodge hospital.

3.53 p.m.—Leave Deer Lodge hospital, thence along the north side of Portage avenue, St. James to Polo park.

4.05 p.m.—Arrive Polo park.

4.10 p.m.—Leave Polo park, thence along the north side of Portage avenue to Sherbrook street.

4.20 p.m.—Pass corner of Sherbrook and Portage avenue and

proceed north on Sherbrook street.

4.26 p.m.—Corner Sherbrook and Bannatyne avenue — proceed along Bannatyne to Emily, Emily to William avenue, William avenue to Isabel.

4.32 p.m.—Corner William and Isabel, proceed along Isabel, over Crosstown bridge, thence north on Salter to Inkster boulevard.

4.44 p.m.—Arrive corner Salter street and Inkster boulevard.

4.46 p.m.—Arrive corner Inkster and Main street, and proceed north along Main street to Kildonan park.

4.52 p.m.—Arrive Kildonan park.

5.02 p.m.—Leave Kildonan park and return by Main street to Canadian Pacific railway station.

5.20 p.m.—Arrive C.P.R. station.

5.50 p.m.—Leave C.P.R. station and proceed along Main street to the Federal building, corner Main and Water streets.

5.58 p.m.—Arrive Federal building.

6.00 p.m.—Arrive city hall, St. Boniface.

6.02 p.m.—Leave city hall, St. Boniface, proceed along Park boulevard to Cathedral street, thence south along Tache.

6.06 p.m.—Pass St. Boniface cathedral.

6.12 p.m.—Arrive St. Mary's road and proceed thence via Norwood bridge to Main street.

6.20 p.m.—Arrive Fort Garry park.

6.25 p.m.—Leave Fort Garry park and proceed along Main street to the Canadian Pacific railway station.
