

# Downie, Green Named To River East School Division Posts

The River East School Division No. 9 announces the appointment of Mr. D. A. Downie as Superintendent of Schools for this Division.

Mr. W. S. Green is appointed Assistant Superintendent of the Division, but will continue his duties as Superintendent of Elementary Education.

Mr. Downie, B.A., B.Ed., M.Ed., is a graduate of the University of Manitoba, currently completing his Ph.D. at the University of Alberta.

Since 1946 he has taught in the Winnipeg area, serving as principal in three St. Vital schools — St. George, Glenwood and Dakota Collegiate.

Mr. Downie is 46 years of age and married, with four children. He is a member and elder of Regents Park United Church.

Mr. Green, B.Paed. (Honors), B.A., B.Ed., M.Ed., received his early education in Portage la Prairie, and graduated from the University of Manitoba in 1954. He is 48 years of age and married, with two children.

His 29 years of teaching experience include 11 years in Portage la Prairie, Minnedosa and Neepawa, 10 years with the Winnipeg School Division, two years in Metropolitan Toronto, five years as principal of Britannia School in St. James, and one year as superintendent of Schools in East Kildonan.

At the present time he is recording steward of the Official Board and secretary of the congregation of Westworth United Church.
