

N.K. Homeowners Advised of Tree Planting Costs

Streets have been selected for the first plantings of boulevard trees in North Kildonan, and home owners are being notified of costs.

The levy has been set at 26c per front foot, amortized over a three year deferred levy basis at 6% per annum.

Secretary - treasurer L. E. Klump points out that this amounts to 10c per front foot per year. On a 100-foot lot, this would amount to a total of \$30.00, whereas if paid im-

mediately would be \$26.00.

In order to hear any complaints from property owners affected by the proposed tree plantings, North Kildonan Council will sit as a court of revision at the Municipal Offices at 7.30 p.m. Tuesday, April 4th. Home owners may then protest against their calculated frontages.

The following boulevards have been designated for the first tree plantings:

Bardal Bay, Broad Bay,

Cedarcrest Drive, Corinne st., De Fehr st., De Graff Bay, De Graff Place, Eade Crescent, Edison ave. (from Henderson Highway to Raleigh st.), Ian Place, Kingsford ave. (from Rothesay to Kingsford Place), Kingsford Place, Macaulay Crescent, Macaulay Place, Mark Pearce ave., Rosewell Place, Sharon Bay, Stalker Bay, Vryenhoek Crescent and Vryenhoek Place.
