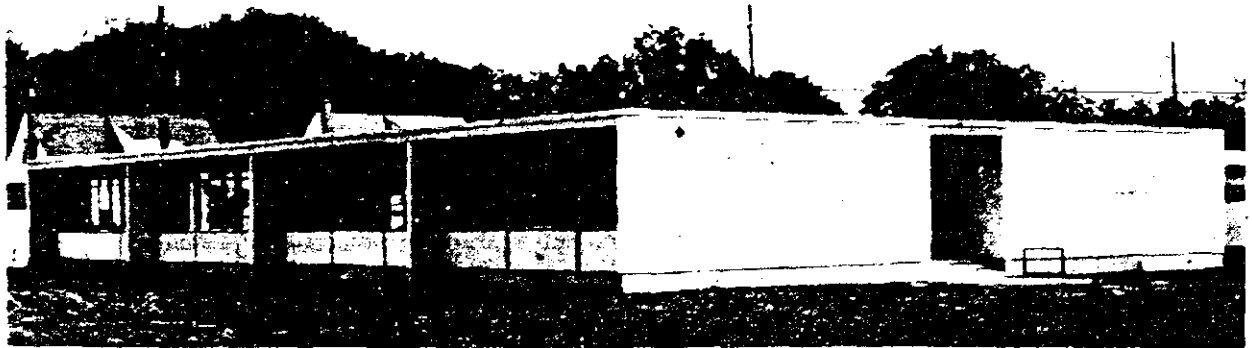

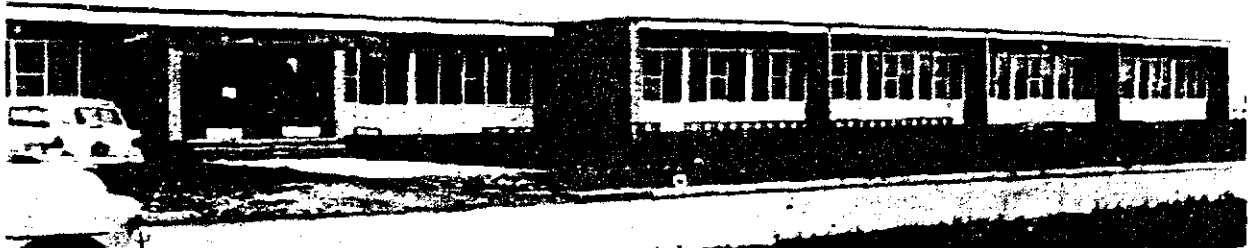
The new **HAMPSTEAD SCHOOL** in the district to the east of the Munroe Shopping Centre has

**POLSON SCHOOL** will move to a new home on September 6th. The addition of eight classrooms to the small elementary school on the north side

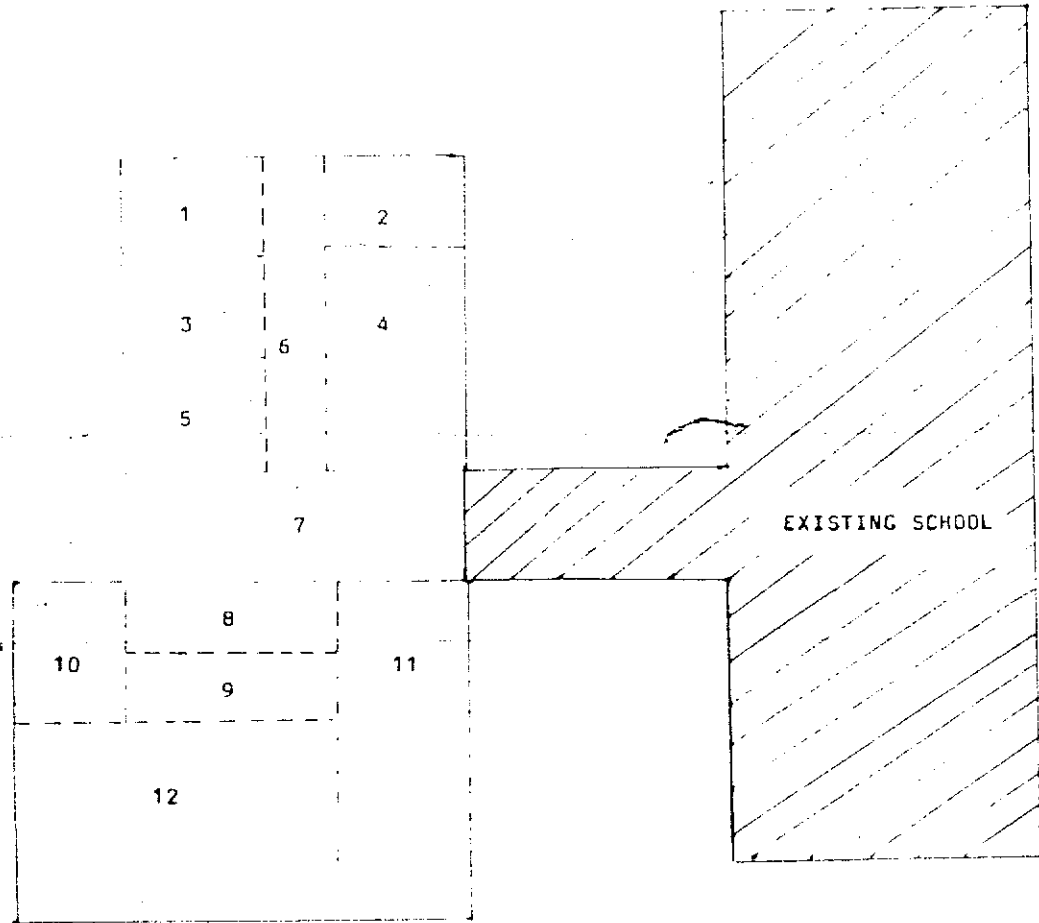
of Munroe avenue gives the district a fine modern building for its oldest school. Mr. R. McElroy is principal.
