An East Kildonan youth and two other Manitobans were honored for deeds of heroism when the annual awards of the Royal Canadian Humane society were announced Monday at Hamilton, Ont.

Included in the list of Canadians who were awarded 14 bronze medals and 36 parchment certificates in recognition of heroic action, the East Kildonan youth whose bravery was honored by the award of a certificate is James McKean of 320 Munro avenue.
