

SUNDAY CARS FOR KILDONAN AT LAST

Run Yesterday For First Time—
Agreement Reached is For
Two Years.

After many delegations from the Kildonan council to the Winnipeg Electric Railway and many agreements between the municipality and the company had been put before the people of Kildonan, an agreement was finally reached last week by the council and the company, and yesterday street cars ran between Kildonan and Winnipeg on Sunday for the first time.

The agreement drawn up last week by a committee from the Kildonan council and the Electric Railway, and which was approved of by the council at its meeting on Saturday, calls for the regular weekly service on Sunday. The agreement is for a period of two years. The council thinks that by the time of the expiration of the agreement the business on the line will have reached a high enough basis to call for a more favorable agreement. The car line will be further improved by installing a switch on each side of the river half-way between Winnipeg and Kildonan. Permission for the switch on the west side of the river has already been passed by the council. On the west side the switch will be located at McBeth's crossing, while on the other side it will be located just north of the east Kildonan school.
