

LOCATES FACTORY IN EAST KILDONAN

Grigg Manufacturing Company of
Minneapolis Establishing Plant
For Farm Implements.

H. S. Grigg, president of the Grigg Manufacturing company, of Minneapolis, is staying at the Royal Alexandra, having returned to Winnipeg after a tour of Western Canada in the interests of his firm, visiting Regina, Moose Jaw, Calgary, Edmonton, Prince Albert, Saskatoon and other points.

On his previous visit to Winnipeg, two months ago, Mr. Grigg purchased 5 1-2 acres in East Kildonan, and completed arrangements for the erection of a factory for the manufacture of agricultural implements and implement specialties, which will be the first of its kind in the prairie provinces.

The buildings and equipment will cost approximately \$100,000. The work is in the hands of Claydon Bros., contractors, who already have the foundations in and are under bond to complete the work and leave the premises ready for occupation by Sept. 1.

The principal business will be the manufacture of bob sleds. From 75 to 100 men will be employed at first, and more will be taken on as the business increases. As far as possible the plant will be operated by Canadians, only a few foremen and skilled mechanics being brought from Minneapolis to start the works, and, being acquainted with the methods followed by the company in the home factory, will serve to assist the new mechanics, if necessary, in any details of the business, thereby enabling them to undertake the work without any delay.
