

Two Suburbs Plan Huge Industry Site

Two Greater Winnipeg suburbs with a common boundary — Transcona and North Kildonan have planned and are developing a joint industrial site that has been described as "one of the finest in Canada."

The 800-acre area, with concrete Nairn road running along one side, lies northwest of Transcona on both sides of the Victoria Beach rail line which, roughly, cuts through the jagged Transcona-North Kildonan boundary.

At present, both municipalities are concentrating on the 300 acres that are on the Transcona side of the rail line.

Details of the site are contained in a brochure recently printed by the Transcona Industrial Development board, headed by Councillor Paul E. Martin.

Both trackage and electric power are available immediately for any industry wanting to locate there. Water lines runs up to the area while sewer lines pass it.

In addition, the proposed natural gas distribution loop that will circle the metropolitan area will pass "if not through, very near" the industrial site.

Industrial board manager Birnie Wolfe said the joint project was the first of its kind to be undertaken by two Greater Winnipeg suburbs.
