

East Kildonan Resident Fatally Hurt in Fall; Traffic Piles Up Toll

An elderly man was killed and six other persons, mostly children, were injured in accidents and misadventure in Greater Winnipeg during the week-end.

The dead man is Carl Yaruck, 63, of 550 Ottawa avenue, East Kildonan, who fell down 11 steps leading to the basement of the Ukrainian hall at Watt street and Jamieson avenue, and fractured his skull, about 12.20 a.m. Sunday. He was carried out to the sidewalk by friends, who telephoned police when he did not recover immediately. He was pronounced dead on arrival at St. Boniface hospital at 1.30 a.m. Dr. H. M. Speechly, provincial coroner, ordered the body removed to Kerr's funeral home. After an investigation Sunday he decided death was accidental and an inquest would be unnecessary.
