

## **GETS NEW BOUNDARIES**

### **Proclamation Defines the Limits of Kildonan Municipality**

Last Thursday the provincial government issued a proclamation dividing the municipality of Kildonan into new wards as follows: Ward one, comprising all land between the southern boundary of lot 97 and the northern boundary of lot 66, Kildonan; ward two, including all territory between the north boundary of lot 120 and the south boundary of lot 65, St. Pauls; ward three occupying all property in Kildonan east of "two mile" or "Panet Road"; ward four covering the river and outer two miles from the north boundary of the city to the north boundary of lot 12, Kildonan; ward five taking in the inner and outer two miles between the north boundary of lot 23 and the south boundary of lot 13, Kildonan, and

ward six including all territory north of the inner and outer two miles of lot 25.

A bylaw, authorizing the borrowing of \$4,500 and the issuing of debentures for same will be submitted to the electors of Odanah Aug. 6, the money to be used in rebuilding the old school, with a new wing added, in the school district of Franklin Union. The funds will be raised by the sale of ten debentures of that district, payable in ten annual installments of \$450 each, with interest at 5 per cent per annum, the first payment falling due Jan. 1, 1907.
