

Grassie School

Grassie was a one room school with a basement built in 1921 at a cost of \$5,000.00 and was located on Grassie near Plessis. It was open only for two years and it was closed in 1923 as a cost cutting measure.

1921-1922 – Grades 1 through 7, a total of 28 students, Daniel Windsor, Teacher and Principal at a salary of \$1,100.00 per year

1922-1923 – Grades 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, and 7, a total of 29 students, Daniel Windsor, Teacher and Principal at a salary of \$1,100.00 per year
