

Dedication Of New Baptist Church Sunday

The Oakview First Baptist Church friends who recently re-located from Elmwood and formerly known as the Beulah Baptist Church, will have their "Open House" on Saturday from 7 to 9 30 p.m. in the building at Oakview and Watt. Rev. Elgar Roberts, of Edmonton, will give an organ recital. Light refreshments will be served.

The new building will be dedicated on Sunday at 3 p.m. Guest preacher will be Rev. Elgar Roberts. The president of the Baptist Union of Western Canada, C. G. Carter, will bring greetings from the Baptist Union.

Others taking part will be the mayor of East Kildonan, the moderator of the Red River Valley Association of Baptist Churches, and others.

Services have been held in the building prior to its completion because the previous building had to be vacated by the end of November.

The present building has a seating capacity for 240 people in the auditorium and a full-sized basement for youth activities and Sunday School. This is the first unit and it is called the Christian Education Building.

The second unit will be used exclusively for church services and will be built later.

The church is a part of the Baptist Federation of Canada through affiliation with the Baptist Union of Western Canada, and consequently, it forms a part of the Baptist World Alliance.
