

Part of Bonner Avenue, North Kildonan, is under up to two feet of water as a result of floodwaters from Bunn's Creek rising over a bridge which normally carries it under Bonner Avenue. The flood occurs every year whenever the Red River rises higher than 14 feet above datum, and its waters back up the creek. While the road is impassable, about 11 families on Bonner Avenue have to make a wide detour to the east to reach Henderson Highway.
