

KILDONAN HAS SITE FOR NEW UNIVERSITY

Negotiating For Fraser's Grove
Near City Park Which May
Be Offered Free.

Manitoba University will receive a free site comprising fifty acres between East Kildonan road and the river, directly opposite the new city park, in the locality known as Fraser's Grove, if negotiations now pending between the Kildonan community club and the owners of the property come to a head. A special committee has been formed to attend to the matter, and options have been secured on all of the five pieces of property involved except one. The site will be given on condition that the university building is erected upon it. As the north corner of the property would only be about ten chains further north than the south boundary of the city park, on the opposite side of the river, it is assumed that the proximity of the two would favor the idea of a bridge at that point in the future.

The land in question is assessed at about \$1,500 an acre. It is the intention to raise the money to purchase it either by private subscription or by passing a money by-law. If the proposed area cannot be secured, the committee have other localities in view.
