If it should be necessary to evacuate all or part of Metropolitan Winnipeg as a result of a National Emergency or Civil Disaster, the information contained on this page may be vital to your safety or survival.

IT'S YOUR LIFE!

Remember these points:

- 1 If evacuation is necessary all vehicles leaving Metropolitan Winnipeg should have a full load of passengers.
- 2 You should make your family plan now and ensure that every member of the family knows how you would put it into operation in varying sets of circumstances.
- 3 If members of a family become separated, because of conditions prevailing in an emergency, remember that a registration and enquiry office will operate in each reception area to help reunite families.
- 4 Wear clothing suitable to prevailing weather conditions, anticipating also what you may require a few weeks ahead.
- 5 Carry one blanket for each member of the family.
- 6 Take enough food with you to meet your family requirements, for at least 48 hours, until emergency feeding facilities are functioning.
- 7 If you can, arrange alternative accommodation with friends or relatives, at least 30 miles outside Metropolitan Winnipeg.
- 8 Study the evacuation route map on page 2 of the Metropolitan Winnipeg Telephone Directory. Learn the easiest way to reach the evacuation route closest to your home. A drive over the evacuation route, making yourself familiar with it, would be in your family's interest.
- 9 Keep your gas tank at least half full at all times.
