

# MOUNTED POLICE

## ADDITIONAL MEN

Being required for the above force, the following information is published for the guidance of those desirous of joining:

- (1)—Candidates must be active, able-bodied men of thoroughly sound constitution and exemplary character. They should be able to ride well, and to read and write either the English or French language.
- (2)—The term of engagement is three years.
- (3)—The rates of payment are as follows:

Staff Constables	\$1.20 per diem
Constables	1.00 "
Sub-Constables	75c "

with free rations; a free kit on joining; clothing; boots; quarters; fuel; and light; and the Government is empowered to give a free grant of 160 acres of land to all well-conducted men on completion of three years service. Extra pay, at the rate of 15 cts. per diem, allowed for one shoeing smith, carpenter, saddler, and tailor per division.

- (5)—Applicants are requested to bring with them any testimonials or certificates of character they may be in possession of.
