

Corner Stone of Municipal Hall To Be Placed Friday

A ceremony of considerable interest to the residents of East Kildonan will take place Friday at 9.30 a.m. when Mayor J. Les. Bodie will officiate at the laying of the cornerstone of the new municipal hall at Helmsdale ave. and Henderson Highway. Municipal and governmental officials will be in attendance.

The building, which is being rushed to completion, will house the municipal offices, the Kildonan-St. Paul Health Unit, the police offices and school board office.

Designed by Green, Blankstein, Russell and Associates, 310 Time Building, the structure will be on ultra-modern lines. It will have fluorescent lighting and will be heated by steam. The basement and foundation are of concrete. The ground floor is partly solid brick and tile frame construction with vertical siding.

A very impressive appearance will be given the front of the building by the use of Roman tile brick. The upper storey will be frame and stucco.

To allow adequate natural lighting the south wall will have 20 windows on the ground floor and eight on the second storey.

It is hoped to have the building ready for occupancy early in September.
