How To Get There

STREET CARS--

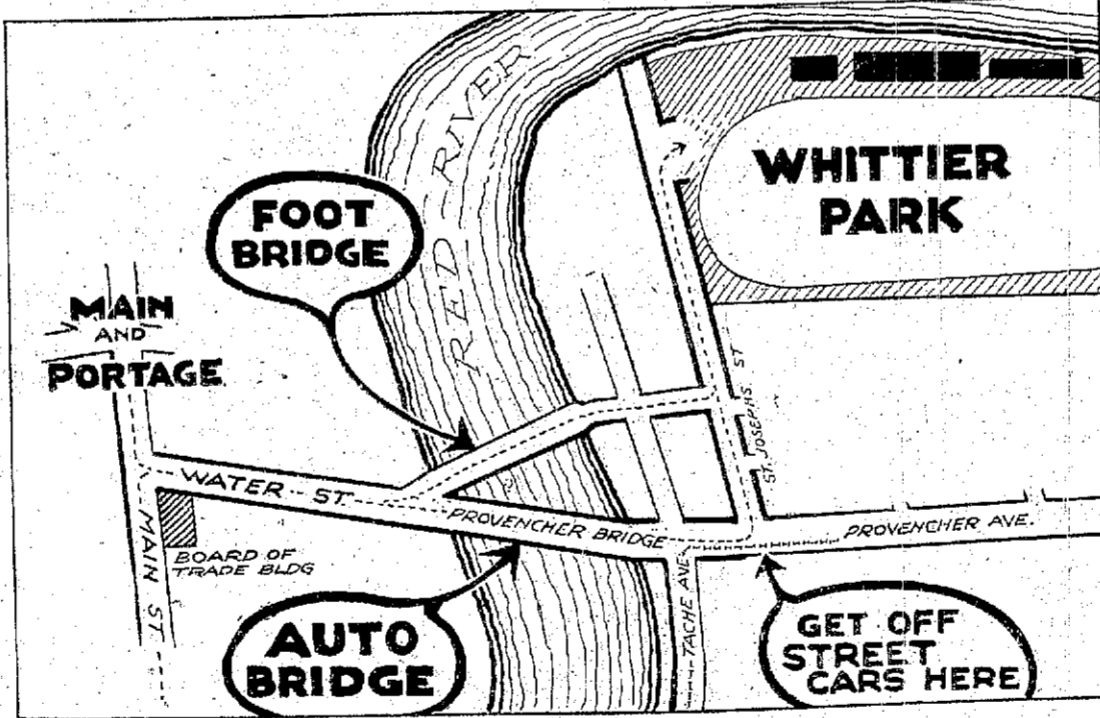
Take St. Boniface cars at corner of Portage and Main; get off at St. Joseph St., and walk North. Time about ten minutes from Portage and Main Sts.

MOTOR CARS--

Water St. East to St. Boniface over Provencher Bridge. Straight East on Provencher St. to second cross street; then North to Park. Time, five minutes from Main and Water Sts.

WALKING--

East on Water St. (at Board of Trade Bldg.), across foot bridge, turn to left at second cross street after leaving bridge—signs all the way. Anyone can walk to the Park in ten minutes.
