

N.K. Police Seek Wage Increase

Large wage increases are being sought by North Kildonan Police Employees Association in their 1968 collective working agreement submission, made to the municipality's personnel committee at the Nov. 7th regular meeting.

The association's solicitor, Roy Gallagher, sent in the re-

vised collective agreement covering wages, holiday schedules, sick pay rights, hospital and medical premium payments, long service pay benefits, and other minor items all to be negotiated.
