

4 Teen-Agers Terrorize Children, Police Told

Four teen - agers terrorized four East Kildonan children Tuesday then stole a bicycle, an East Kildonan man reported Wednesday.

Ed Scrapneck, of 708 Fleming Avenue, said in an interview his two sons David, 7, and Danny, 9, were lying on the grass at King Edward Park playing cards with Cindy, 8, and Kimberley Jones, 9.

"The four teen-agers, two girls and two boys, came up and started throwing the cards around and tearing them.

"Then one of the girls took my son's bike. When the boys tried to get it back from her, she kicked them, stomped them and slapped their faces."

The incident has been reported to Winnipeg and East

Kildonan police, who are investigating.

The stolen bicycle has a red frame, white fenders and a wire basket and is described as a junior road bike.

"It was David's most prized possession," Mr. Scrapneck said. "I drove all over the area looking for those kids. One of the girls had long blonde hair and the other one had short brunette hair.

"Maybe it's just as well I couldn't find them. There may have been a charge against me."

He said it was time local parents started finding out what their children were doing in their free time. "The caretaker of the park said about five bikes have been stolen from the park recently. Who is bringing up these kids like this?"
