

KILDONAN CRICKETERS IN ANNUAL SESSION

**Mr. Geo. W. Cooper Re-Elected
President — Mr. Jas. McAnsh
Asked to Again Discharge the
Duties of Secretary-Treasurer**

At the annual business meeting of the East Kildonan cricket club, held in the Free Press board room Wednesday night of last week, Mr. Geo. W. Cooper was unanimously re-elected president of the club for another term. Mr. E. H. Macklin was again elected honorary president and Mr. J. F. Sweeney honorary vice-president. Other officers elected were: Mr. D. M. Dobbie, first vice-president, and Mr. Harry Thompson, second vice-president. The executive committee is comprised of Messrs. C. S. Dakin, Fred Butterworth and W. Wright, while Mr. Jas. McAnsh was again asked to fill the position of secretary-treasurer.

It was decided to run two teams in the Winnipeg league this season, one in "A" and one in "C." The team captains and vice-captains are: "A" team, Messrs. E. D. Forster and W. Wright; "C" team, Messrs. Fred Butterworth and Josh Clay. Delegates to the association meetings will be Messrs. J. McAnsh and C. S. Dakin, with Mr. J. O. Ward as alternative.

The club has added one or two new players to its list, but is still open to receive cricketers who have not yet fixed up to play in the current season. The first game will be played May 16, in the "A" division, while other leagues will start a week later.

Notice will be given when park pitches are available for practice.

The club has made a very fine record during the past three years. In 1928 they won the championship of "C" division, were promoted to "B" division in 1929 and topped it at the first time of asking. They were promoted further still in 1930 to "A" division, and completed a very good season by being comfortably settled in third place.
