

Officers Elected For New Ski Club In East Kildonan

A long overdue recreational project became a reality with the formation of the Kildonan Ski club, thus providing Greater Winnipeg with additional skiing facilities. A general meeting was held last Wednesday evening at the Kildonan Community hall.

The property was donated by the Municipality of East Kildonan in another forward step in their ever-expanding recreational program. The site is on the banks of the Red river at the foot of Bronx ave. and Kildonan Drive. Considerable work has already been done and the clubhouse will be started by Nov. 1.

Intense enthusiasm was shown by the community as approximately 175 persons attended the meeting. For the first year the membership will be restricted to 200 seniors and 100 juniors.
