HOW CANADIAN MILITIA WOULD BE PAID IN SERVICE.

The fact that the militia units in Winnipeg may be called to the front has aroused a great deal of interest and the pay that those who do go is a matter that is also of vital interest to those who may be affected.

Below is the list. It will be noticed that there is an extra allowance for "active service."

There are, of course, other special allowances, but the average pay is as above, and covers the cavalry, artillery, infantry, engineers, signal corps, A.S.C. and the Postal corps.
