The Fire Department consists of 4 platoons of 6 men each. There is 1 ambulance operated and maintained by the Fire Department. The ambulance is driven by a firefighter who is joined at the scene by a police officer that travels with him in the ambulance to the hospital.

In December 1971 Deputy Fire Chief Mallows complains that he works 40 hours per week while the Captains work 42 hours per work. They receive overtime pay for more than their regular 42 hours per week. Deputy Chief Mallows is on call for the remaining 128 hours per week for which he receives no extra pay. He is only not on call one weekend per month, but his salary is not much higher than a Captain and with overtime a Captain often makes more.
