

East Kildonan Unemployed.—Two hundred and fifty of the unemployed of East Kildonan assembled on Jamieson avenue yesterday evening and were addressed by several, among whom were: J. Amtrobus, H. Kondunet, E. Dell. The speakers said in effect that municipal work, instead of being performed by day labor, had been contracted for. To make this worse, they said, the contractors had brought out city men instead of giving the work to the residents of East Kildonan. No time was lost in forming a delegation which proceeded to the residence of Councillor Whellans. After listening to the arguments of the delegation, the councillor promised to try to arrange for a special meeting of the council tonight to discuss the problem.
