

SAVE THIS MAP . . . It Could Save Your Life

CIVIL DEFENCE RULES

1. Know your escape routes and your point of destination — it may mean your survival. Study this map and SAVE it for reference.
2. Know your warning system and what the signals mean.
3. On siren warnings, tune in your local radio station. Do not use the telephone.
4. On evacuation, be sure that full seating capacity of your car is used.
5. Those without their own transportation should proceed to their neighborhood collecting point for bus, truck or train accommodation. (Location of various collecting points to be notified shortly.)
6. Take with you warm clothing and enough foodstuffs to last forty-eight hours.
7. Keep your head — THINK — DON'T PANIC.
8. Under enemy attack conditions, all evacuation routes will be one way **OUTBOUND ONLY**.
9. Obey your Police and Civil Defence instructions.
10. On arrival at destination, report to check point where registration and billeting will be arranged.
11. Be sure your car is kept filled with gas.

If Siren Sounds — Know Its Meaning EVACUATION ALERT SIGNAL . . .

A steady blast of 3 to 5 minutes on sirens.
WHAT TO DO

There IS time to evacuate — Organize your family for immediate evacuation.

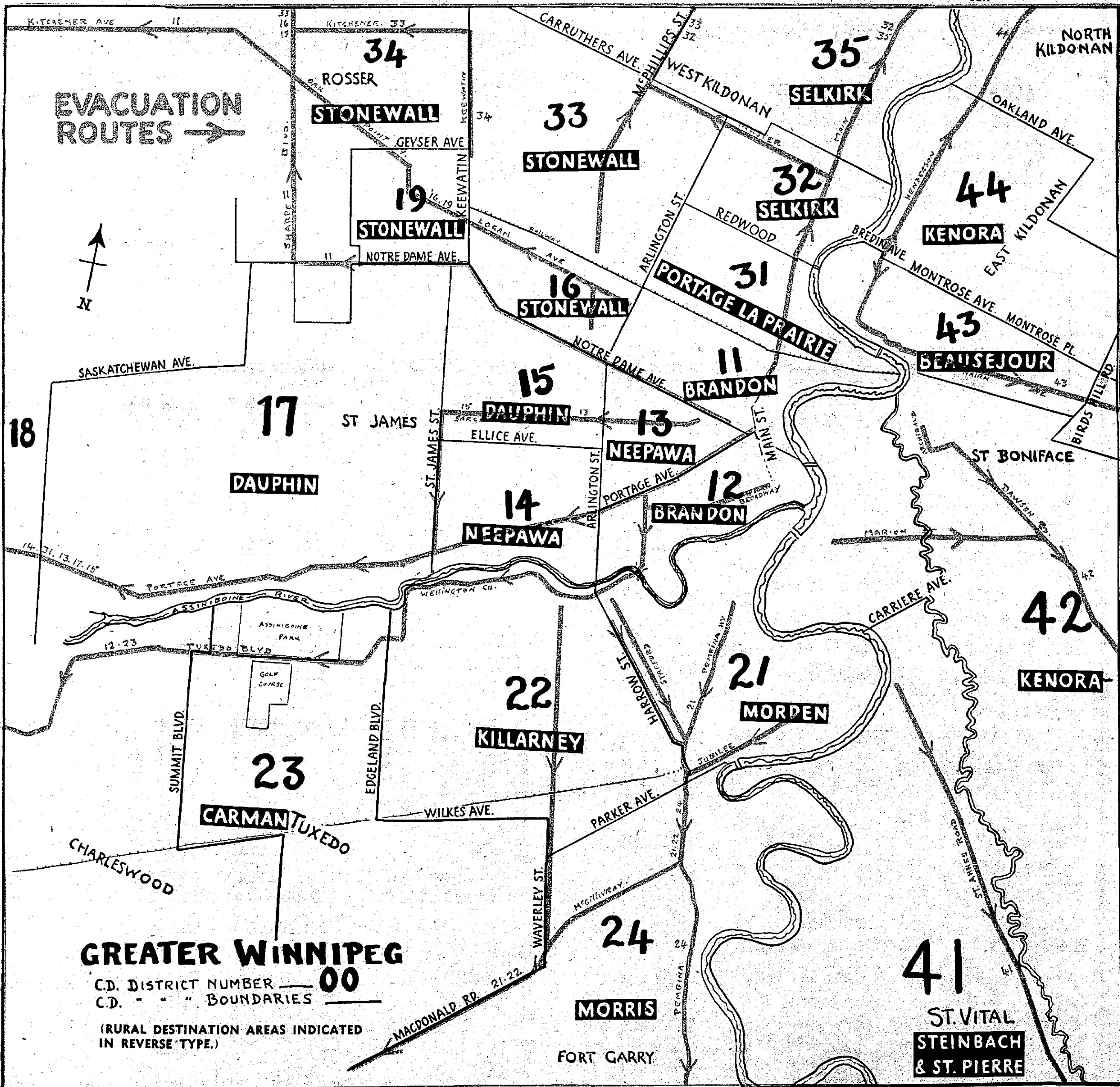
TAKE COVER SIGNAL . . .

Wailing tone for 3 minutes on sirens.
WHAT TO DO

There is NO time to evacuate —
AT HOME: Get into your home shelter immediately. If you have none, shut all outside doors and windows and take cover in the basement or first-floor room.

OUTDOORS: Seek the best available cover INSTANTLY.

STAY PUT until you get word to come out.
