

KILDONAN RESIDENT SAVES SCHOOLHOUSE

Finds Building on Fire and Shovels Snow Till Flames Are Out

McEvor school, North Kildonan, was saved from destruction by flames last evening through the prompt action of R. H. Frinthrop, North Kildonan, who was working in a field nearby. Seeing a glow in the building, he investigated, to find flames eating a hole through the other side of the structure and just breaking through the floor. Several school children playing a few yards away were sent to neighboring house to summon aid. Mr. Frinthrop scooped quantities of snow on the flames from the outside and extinguished the fire inside the building with pails of water. The damage was estimated last night as about \$25. The school will not be closed today as the class rooms are not touched.

Hot ashes beside the building are believed to have started the blaze.

Fire apparatus from the neighboring municipality of East Kildonan was rushed to the scene of the fire, but arrived to find the blaze out. The East Kildonan trucks were in the ditch several times on the way out, the firemen saying that the roads were very rough.

N. Kildonan Will Erect New School

Ratepayers of Melvor school district No. 2323 in North Kildonan Tuesday voted unanimously in favor of a \$35,000 bylaw to erect a two-room school on Bird's Hill road at McLeod avenue. Fifty voters turned out.

Completion of the building is expected in November, according to W. deGraaf, chairman of the Melvor school board.
