

East Kildonan Polio Cases Now Total Thirty-Four

While the polio epidemic appears to be tapering off in the main, the situation is not yet back to the normal average number of cases which is relatively few compared to the present number.

During the end of September and the beginning of October there were four cases of polio. Three of these were in East Kildonan and one was in North Kildonan.

To date there have been two deaths in East Kildonan from the disease. There were none in North Kildonan or East St. Paul at last report. The number of cases to the present totals 34 in East Kildonan, ten in North Kildonan, and one in East St. Paul.
