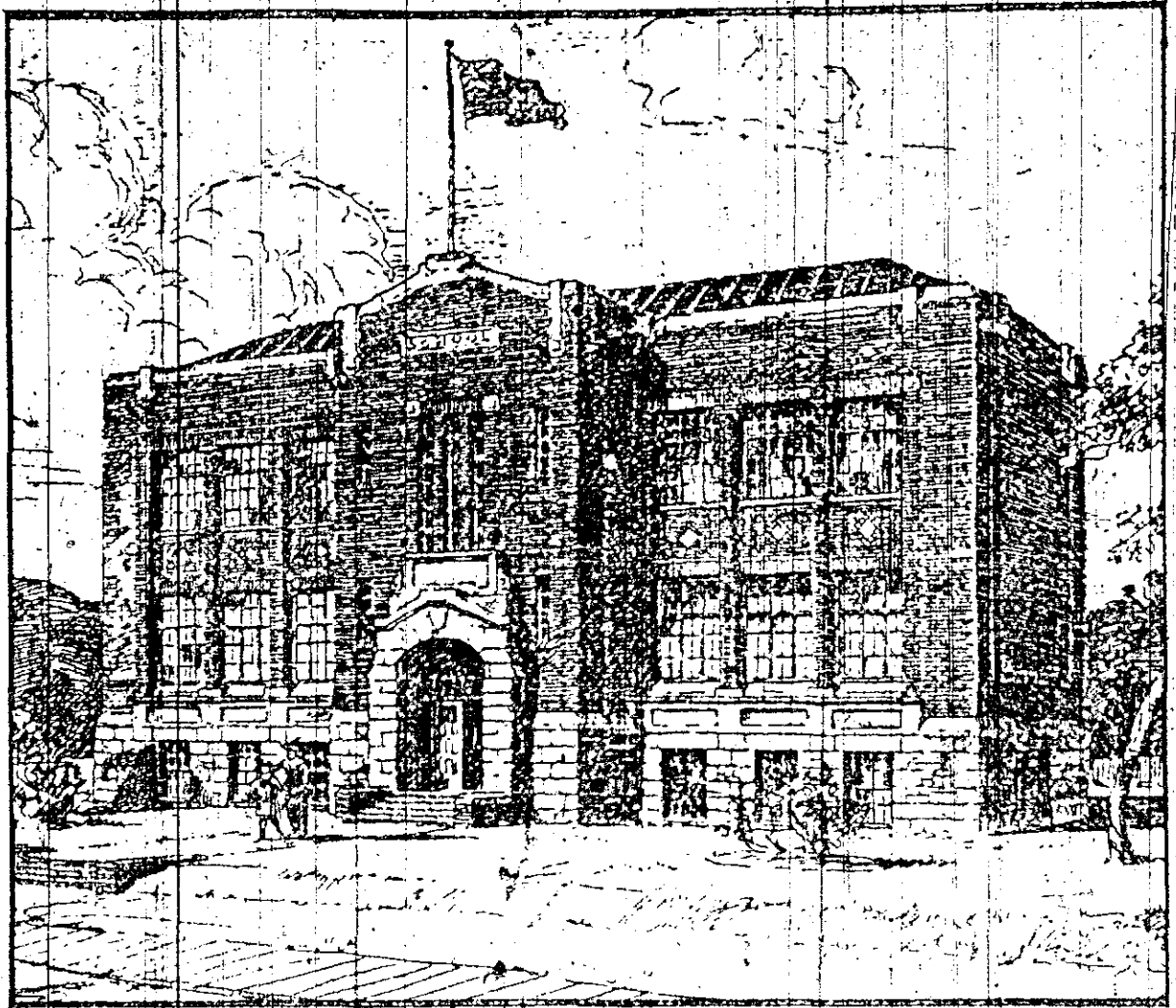


EAST KILDONAN'S BIG PROJECT



Bylaw to Raise \$225,000 to Build Four New Schools To Be Discussed at Meeting Tuesday Night.

The municipality of East Kildonan proposes spending \$225,000 on four new schools and a bylaw will be submitted to the ratepayers on June 27. In order that the question may be thoroughly discussed a meeting of the ratepayers will be held in the Polson school on Tuesday evening next at 8 o'clock. The sites are already in sight and one school will be built at Morse Place, one at North Transcona and two along the main road. The school shown above is the one to be built at Morse Place. The others will be much the same.

The building shown above is to be entirely fireproof, being built of stone and brick with steel windows. It will be two and a half stories high and 90 feet long by 30 feet wide. The present plans are for a four room building although the intention is to increase it later to 10 rooms. Inside the staircase will be lined with face brick. The stairs and corridors will be floored with asphalt. Modern heating and ventilating apparatus will be installed.
